

Self-Driven Innovation program on "Scope of Innovation in Nano-electronics and Possible Roles India Can Play"







He introduced the Scheme Expedited examination and elucidated the eligible criteria for that. He concluded his speech by creating an awareness on the available jobs in the field of IP. The chief guest answered the questions clearly during the Q&A session.

development. The event provided ample networking opportunities for our faculty and


students to connect with peers from other institutions, industry professionals, and potential
