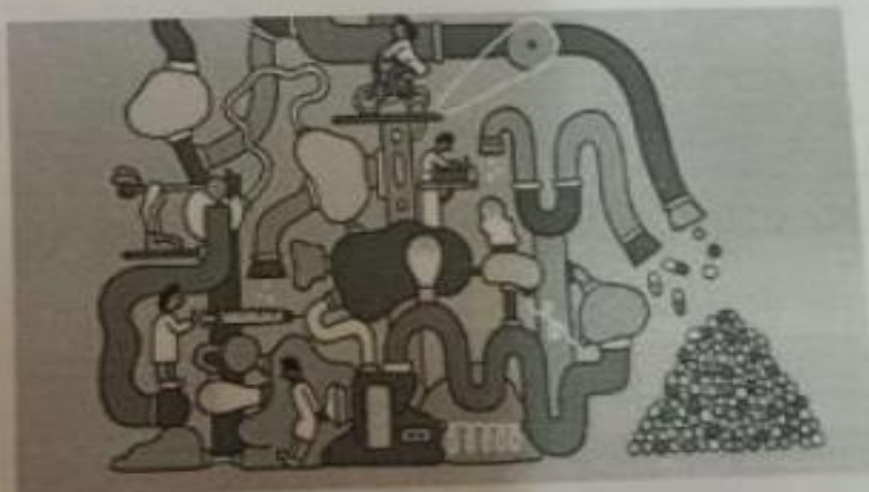


Social Outreach Programme

## **“BIOMEDICAL AND ECONOMICAL VALUE OF FLOWERS”**

**Date: 8.02.2020 (Saturday)**

Flowers are a primary example of mutualism in nature and source of nutrition to the pollinating organisms. *Chrysanthemum* flower cultivation is very popular in Tamilnadu and occupies 9 percent of total flower area in the state. In Trichy, flower cultivation, especially chrysanthemum, is the most cultivated flowering plant in and around the area of Ettarai. A major initiative for floriculture development was taken during the VIII five year plan by launching a central sector scheme .The sector also provides good employment opportunities to the farmers especially to small and marginal farmers and female labour.

Keeping this in view, The Department of Biochemistry organized the field study & research view on “Biomedical & Economical value of flowers” in the Panchayat Union Hall, Ettarai. The Programme was held on 8.02.2020 at 10.00.a.m. Around 100 farmers from the village and 96 students from the Department of Biochemistry and Economics participated in the programme. Mr S.Divya Anburasu President, Panchayat Union and Mr.Parimala, Vice-president, Panchayat union, Panchayat ward members, Ms.P.Anitha Head, Department of Biochemistry, Shrimati Indira Gandhi College inaugurated the Programme.

The main objective of the programme was to create awareness among the students about the excellent opportunities for the production and export of high value horticultural products including flowers.



Ms.P.Anitha and Dr.B.Varalakshmi, Assistant Professors, Department of Biochemistry gave an important speech about the medicinal importance and high economical product value of flowers. Ms.S.Gomathi and Dr.C.Sumathy, Assistant Professors, Department of Biochemistry explained about the field study of *Chrysanthemum* flower cultivation to the Biochemistry and Economics students.

A Farmer of Ettarai explained that chrysanthemum is a short day plant and planting should be done during April-May. The three most important of the essential elements are nitrogen (N), phosphorus (P) and potassium (K) was required for the cultivation of flowers. The non availability of labor and credit, adverse climate, incidence of pest, high fertilizer costs, high irrigation costs were major constraints faced by the farmers. In the marketing of flowers, the flowers were transported to the Srirangam market by the individual farmers.

The programme was concluded by Ms.Latha Assistant Professor, Department of Economics shared her research view on cultivation and economical value of flowers in and around Ettarai village and also gave an idea to become a women entrepreneur through the cultivation of flowers.
