innovative research is the need of the hour. She addressed that Information technology is also playing a vital role in undergoing effective research in Management and Commerce. She insisted that the Era of E-Business, collaboration with Corporates, and financial Institutions, Researchers could undertake innovative research in Finance. She also

explained how softwares, Artificial Intelligence could be used for undertaking financial Research.

Dr. M. Selvam, Chief Editor of SMART Journal listed out the inputs useful to prepare and publish research article in top Journal.

Prof. Balasundram Maniam, Sam Houston State University, USA delivered the special address. He shared his view about changing scenario in academia and the importance of being pro-active to face the challenges in area of research.

Prof. Bala Sundramaniam, Sam Heustan State University USA delivered a special Lecture on **“Publish or Perish”**. The constant changing Publication world in Academics Readership. Prestige, availability, subject scope, peer review process and acceptance rate should all be considered when

choosing a journal. He advised the audience to publish the research work in the journal which has more impact. Publication is a lifetime commitment for an academician. He motivated the audience to come out of the fear of rejection in the initial stages of publication. He suggested co-authoring, understanding the peer review process and utilizing the subject knowledge and statistical skills for data collection to publish a quality research paper. Publication should be done with a positive approach such as to understand the research results and to popularize that by sharing not by compulsion. He said ‘Writing and Publishing is an Art’. He suggested that the Title of the paper should be suitable and appropriate. He enlightened the audience about the expectations of standard journals such as quality data analysis and way of writing and explaining. While selecting the journal he insisted on checking whether the journal is indexed international available online etc. Identify ‘hot’ research topics within the area of expertise e.g. Energy Economics Trade Agreements Trade Imbalance etc. He asked the researchers to read elaborately various research publications. By reviewing like that the researchers can identify the research gap. He explained how showing the managerial and public implications of the findings will help in getting the article published.

In **Plenary Session II – Dr. M. Selvam**, Dean, Faculty of Management, Professor and Head, Department of Commerce and Financial Studies, Bharathidasan University and Chief Editor, SMART Journal of Business Management Studies delivered a Special Lecture on **“Article Writing and Publication in Journal”**.



In his lecture he expressed the expectations of Journals from the researchers. He explained the importance of publishing article which are socially relevant and contributing to Corporate Sector. He explained the most popular types of Research Papers such as, Argumentative Papers, Analytical papers. Interpretive papers, self explanatory papers, compare and contrast papers and course effect papers. He said that Academicians should make Research Publication as a regular habit and life style. He shared the Essential Qualities of good paper such as clarity of ideas, uses of concepts, socially relevant problem, presentation, language etc. He advised the researchers to concentrate on particular area and

specialize on that area. Focus in a particular area will result in excellence. He has enlightened the audience about avoiding plagiarism and publishing original content. He explained about how to give citation and reference in an article.

In the Valedictory session Dr. J. Francis Mary, Director, Management Studies, Shrimati Indira Gandhi College welcomed the gathering. **Dr. S. Balakrishnan**, Nizwa College of Applied Sciences, Sultanate of Oman, delivered the valedictory address and distributed the certificates to the participants. Totally 566 participants (which include students, research scholars and faculty members from various Universities

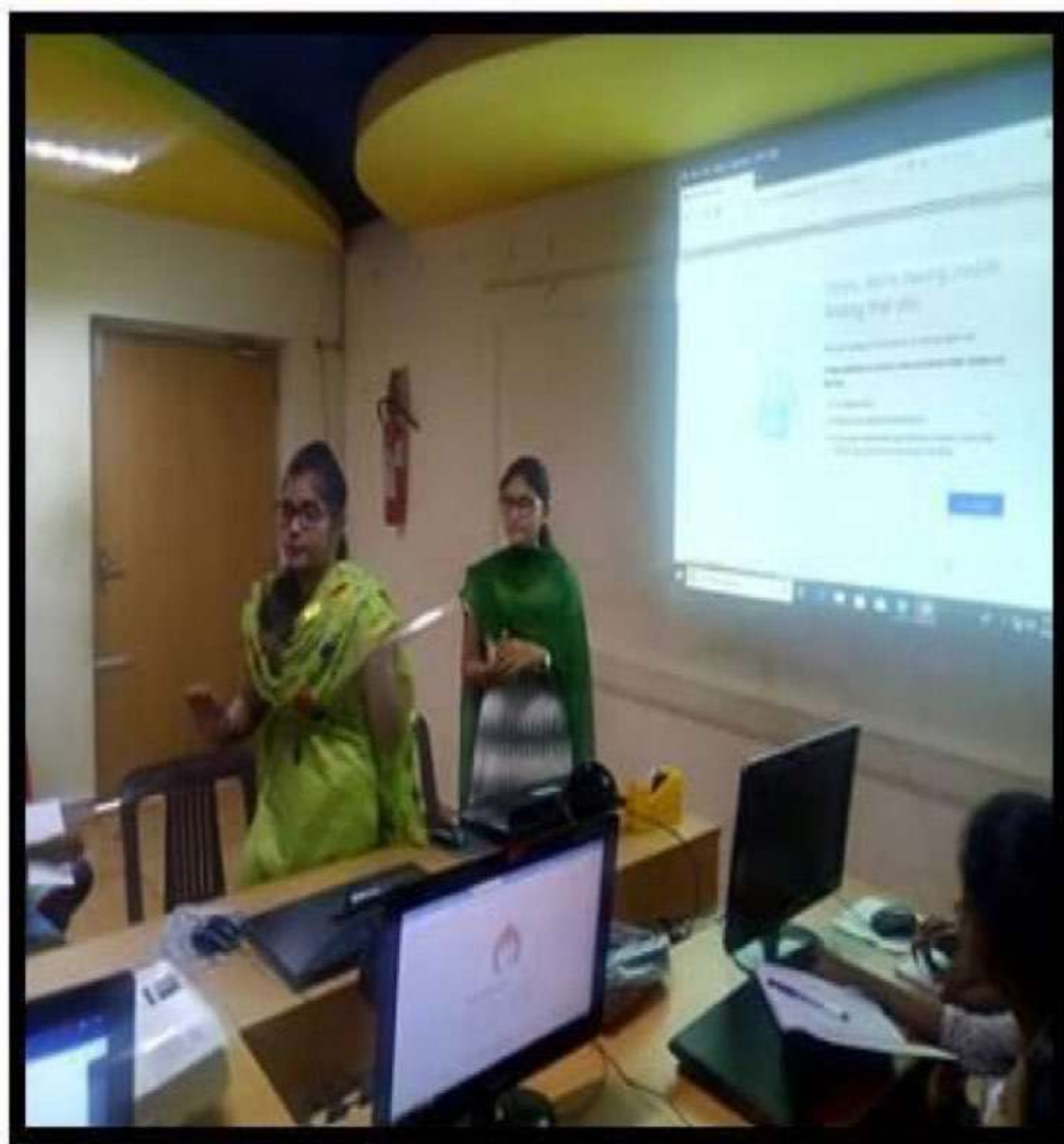

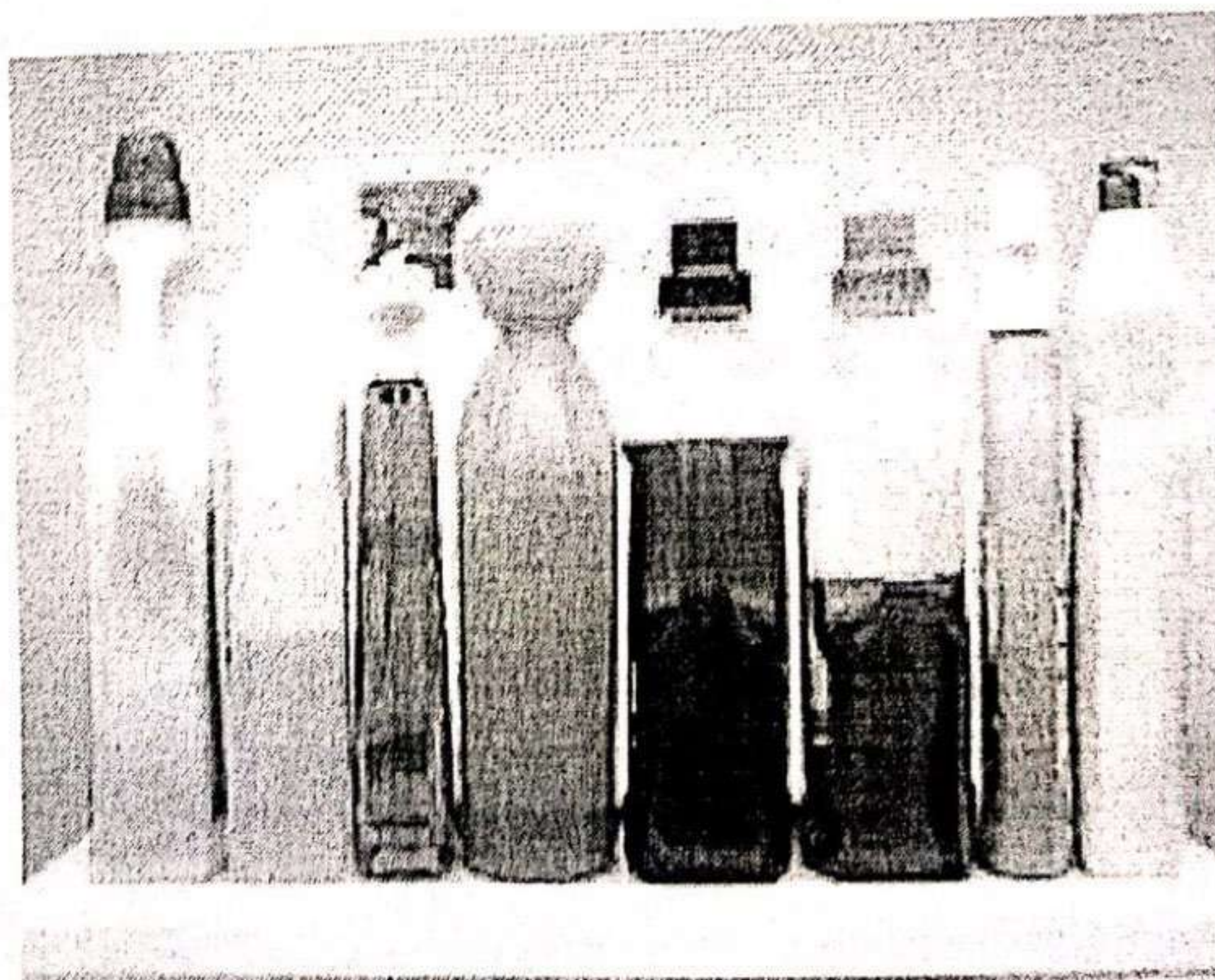

Research view on “BIOMEDICAL AND ECONOMICAL VALUE OF FLOWERS”

Date: 8.02.2020 (Saturday)

Flowers are a primary example of mutualism in nature and source of nutrition to the pollinating organisms. *Chrysanthemum* flower cultivation is very popular in Tamilnadu and occupies 9 percent of total flower area in the state. In Trichy, flower cultivation, especially chrysanthemum, is the most cultivated flowering plant in and around the area of Ettarai. A major initiative for floriculture development was taken during the VIII five year plan by launching a central sector scheme. The sector also provides good employment opportunities to the farmers especially to small and marginal farmers and female labour.

Keeping this in view, The Department of Biochemistry organized the field study & research view on “Biomedical & Economical value of flowers” in the Panchayat Union Hall, Ettarai. The Programme was held on 8.02.2020 at 10.00.a.m. Around 100 farmers from the village and 96 students from the Department of Biochemistry and Economics participated in the programme. Mr S.Divya Anburasu President, Panchayat Union and Mr.Parimala, Vice-president, Panchayat union, Panchayat ward members, Ms.P.Anitha Head, Department of Biochemistry, Shrimati Indira Gandhi College inaugurated the Programme.

The main objective of the programme was to create awareness among the students about the excellent opportunities for the production and export of high value horticultural products including flowers. Ms.P.Anitha and Dr.B.Varalakshmi, Assistant Professors, Department of Biochemistry gave an important speech about the medicinal importance and high economical product value of flowers. Ms.S.Gomathi and Dr.C.Sumathy, Assistant Professors, Department of Biochemistry explained about the field study of *Chrysanthemum* flower cultivation to the Biochemistry and Economics students.

A Farmer of Ettarai explained that chrysanthemum is a short day plant and planting should be done during April-May. The three most important of the essential elements are nitrogen (N), phosphorus (P) and potassium (K) was required for the cultivation of flowers. The non availability of labor and credit, adverse climate, incidence of pest, high fertilizer costs, high irrigation costs were major constraints faced by the farmers. In the marketing of flowers, the flowers were transported to the Srirangam market by the individual farmers. The programme was concluded by Ms.Latha Assistant Professor, Department of Economics shared her research view on cultivation and economical value of flowers in and around Ettarai village and also gave an idea to become a women entrepreneur through the cultivation of flowers.

knowledge of the course. Students were eager to attend advanced course in beauty culture. This course outcome prepares the students to be an independent entrepreneur in future.

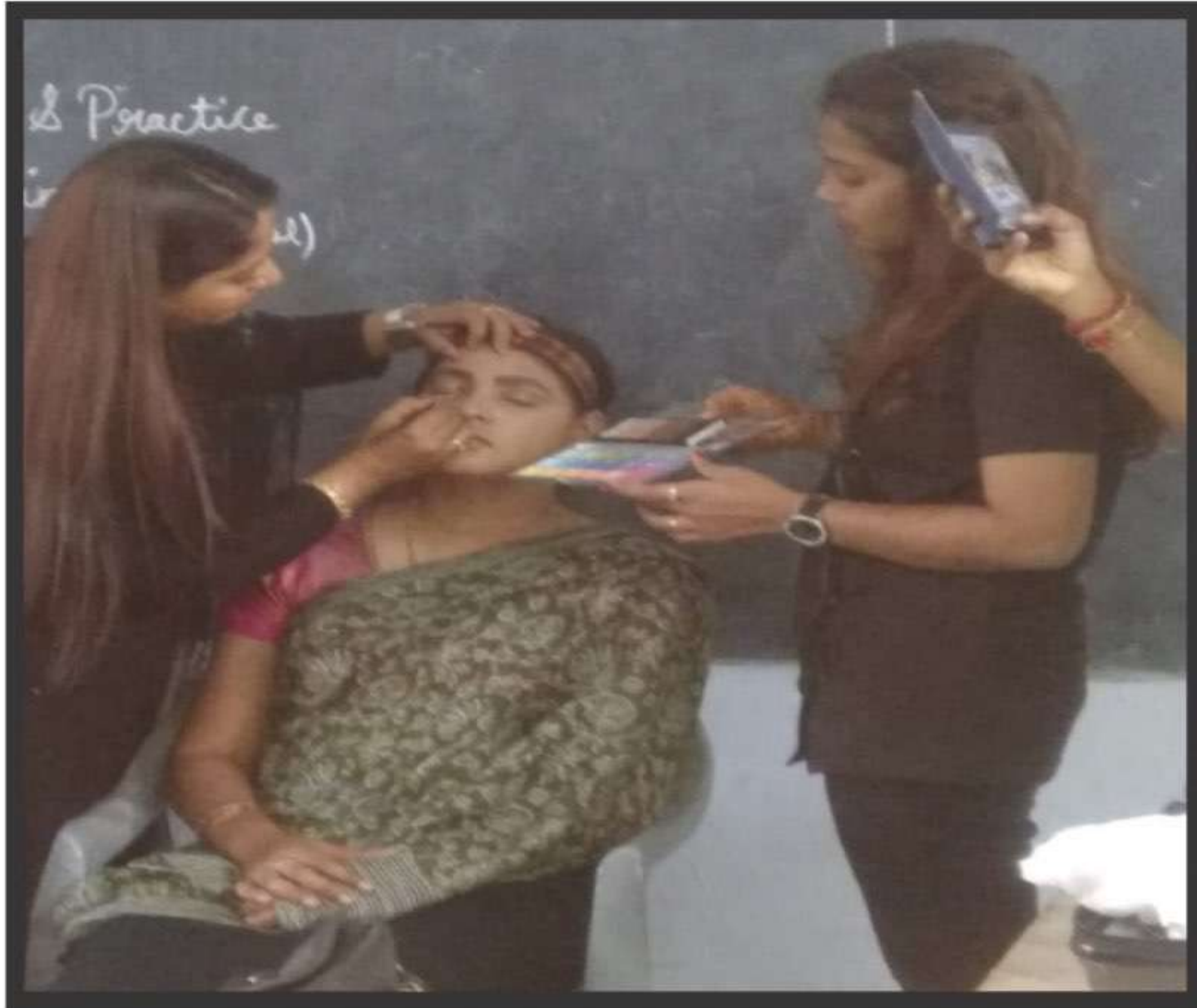

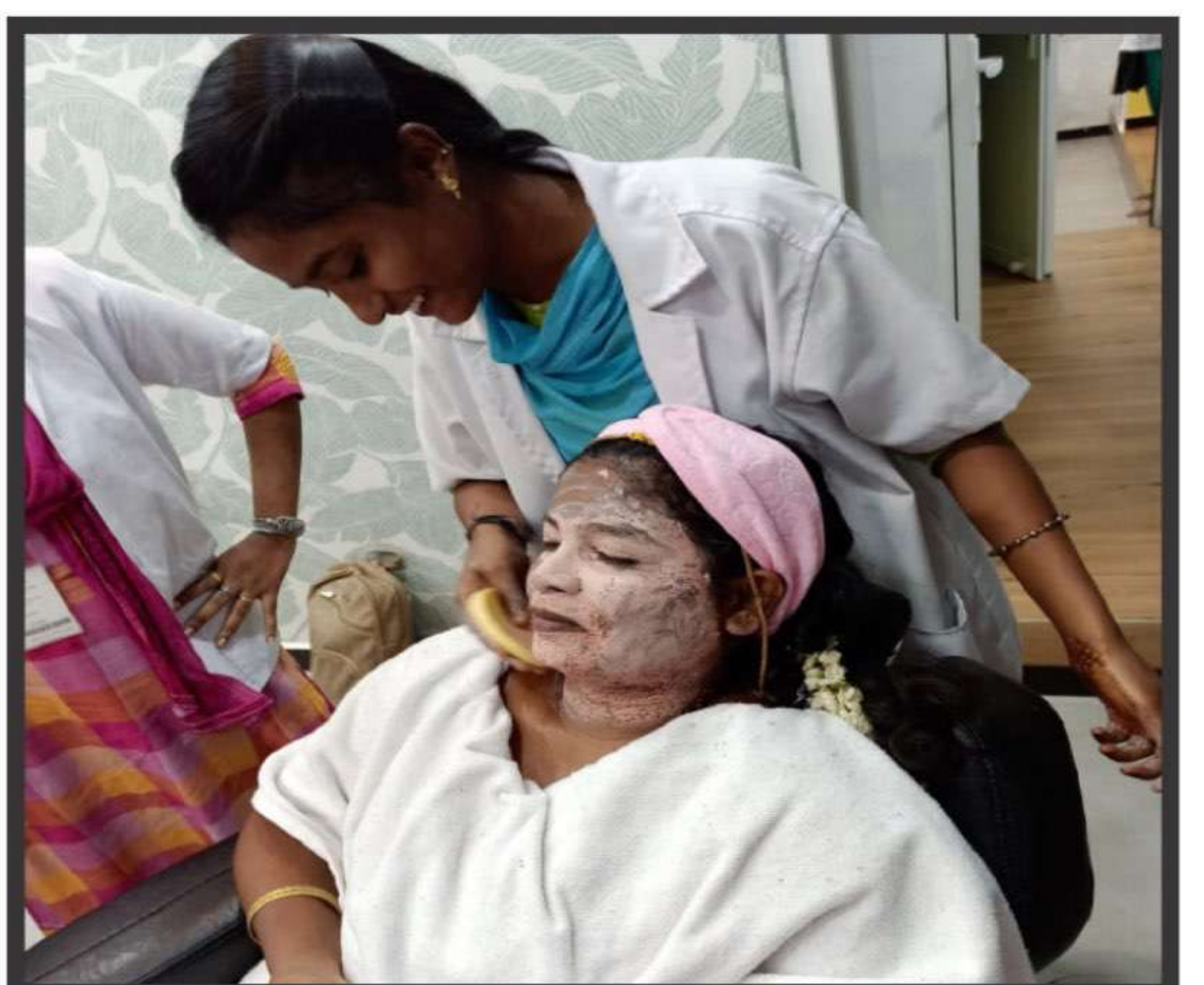
