"Production of Vermiwash"

The Department of Biochemistry organized a programme on "Production of Vermiwash" in the Garden near the canteen. The Programme started at 10.00.a.m. Around 35 students from I & II MSc Biochemistry participated and benefited from this programme.

Ms P.Anitha (Head), and Ms.S.Gomathi, Associate Professor, Department of Biochemistry demonstrated on the production of Vermiwash. Vermiwash contains excretory products and mucus secretions of earthworms, growth hormones and micronutrients from soil. Vermiwash has high quantities of Nitrogen, Phosphate, Potassium, Sodium, Calcium, Copper, Magnesium, Manganese and Zinc. Vermiwash is diluted with water (10%) before spraying. This has been found to be very effective on several plants. Vermiwash may be mixed with cow's urine and diluted and sprayed on plants to function as an effecting foliar spray and pesticide helping plant growth and preventing infections.
