1. About SCOPE

Society for Community Organization and Peoples Education (SCOPE) is an NGO based in Trichy. It was established in 1986 and concentrates on rural development and women empowerment of marginalized women in rural areas. It specializes in Eco-sanitation and has constructed over 2000 Ecosan toilets on the banks of the Ganges and Cauveri in rural areas including Tsunami hit coastal villages of Tamilnadu. 201 Ecosan Compost toilets were constructed in two villages in Musiri. It has also designed and constructed Sanitary Napkin Incinerator at various places. It specializes in solid waste management and vermicomposting. It has also provided support for research in paddy and banana cultivation using the manure generated through its projects. It has established a Urine Bank and STRUVITE collection. It was awarded with the Nirmal Gram Puraskar Award from the Govt, of India in 2006.

2. About Shrimati Indira Gandhi College

Shrimati Indira Gandhi College is a Self-Financing college affiliated to the Bharathidasan University and accredited by NAAC at 'A' grade during the III cycle in 2015. The college was established in 1984 by the visionary educationalist Vidya Seva Ratnam Shri . K. - vi. Motivating women and children to study and undergo vocational education to become employable.
- vii. Creating awareness on rainwater harvesting, conservation of energy, use of renewable energy sources, eco-friendly practices.

8. Financial Provisions:

13. Arbitrations:

This MoU shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of courts in the location of Shrimati Indira Gandhi College and SCOPE.
