Special Camp Report 2021 – 2022



The NSS Units (5) of Shrimati Indira Gandhi College, Tiruchirappalli organized a 7 Day Special Camp from **02.01.2022** to **08.01.2022** at '**PAGALAVAADI**', Thuraiyur under the topic "**YOUTH FOR CLEANLINESS**" in the adopted villages of Pagalavaadi,

Singalandhapuram, Ammapatti, Ammapatti (East) and Kaalipatti. Due to the Pandemic situation the camp was held only for four days.

The NSS Volunteers kick started their services with an inauguration on 02.01.2022 at 11.00 a.m. in Panchayat Union Primary School, Pagalavaadi. The Chief guest of the day was Thaaiveedu Mr.S.M.Sivakumar, Family Welfare Counselor, Tiruchirappalli and the special camp was inaugurated under the presence of Mrs. Chellammal, President, Mr.V.Ramar, Clerk and Mrs. Maheswari, Councillor.



The foremost service done by the NSS Volunteers was to bring awareness of corona vaccination and they duly participated in the vaccination camp conducted

in the village followed by a rally and distribution of masks to the village people.



In the afternoon session, at 2.30 p.m. a special lecture programme was organized for the NSS Volunteers. Thaaiveedu **Mr.S.M.Sivakumar**, Family Welfare Counselor, Tiruchirappalli was the speaker of the session. He gave a special lecture on

the topic “**Sindhanai Sei Manamae**” to create an awareness in the psyhological way among the Volunteers. There was an interactive session to clear the doubts regarding the same for the Volunteers. He also insisted many ethical and moralistic values of life such as self confidence, to respect parents, concentrate on studies facing the difficulties with a positive way in their life by conducting balloon fun games. Finally he concluded the lecture by stating that suicide is not the solution for all problems.



The second day (03.01.2022) of the special camp the NSS Volunteers went to Singalandhapuram village to render their services. They began with lighting of Kuthuvilakku in the presence of Thuraiyur Panchayat Union leaders.



In this programme Ms.D.Jeyapradha, Asst.Professor, Dept. of Fashion Technology along with the NSS Volunteers trained the village people on ‘Cushion Making’ and motivated them to develop the skill to be improve their financial status. The same day the rally was flagged off by Mr.M.Mathiyalagan , Programme Co-ordinator. Then the volunteers went to each house to collect a survey regarding the new voters in that area.



In the Afternoon session, at 2.30 p.m. a special lecture programme was organized, in which Mr.S.Radhakrishnan, First Aid Lecturer & Trainer, St.John Ambulance, Tiruchirappalli was the speaker. He gave a special lecture on the topic “ Uyir Kakkum

Unnatham’ to create an awareness on First Aid and how to prevent and escape from accidents. There was an interactive session to clear the doubts regarding first-Aid. At the end of the session, the NSS

On the third day of the special camp (04.01.2022), the Volunteers reached Ammapatti village and started the day with lighting of the lamp in the presence of the Village Heads.
