Dr.B. Balamurali Krishnan, Assistant Professor, Department of Food Science and Biotechnology, Sejong University, South Korea pontificates the significance of biochemistry in the fields of Medicine, Diagnostics, Pharmaceuticals, Biotechnology, Veterinary, Agriculture and Dairy Sciences. Manoharan, Associate Professor, Department of Marine Science, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli focused on fundamental ideas and skills needed for the students to get the jobs in the field of Biochemistry. They pointed out an increasing demand for biochemists in biochemical genetic research laboratories all over the world. He also listed out the various central research institutes in India for research. At the end of the session, the resource persons answered the question posed by the students.

She gave a brief introduction about the importance of Breastfeeding, methods of consumption and reason for low milk supply. S. Ilakkaiya of III B.Sc Biochemistry elaborated the significant role played by breastfeeding in mother's and baby's health. She also pointed out the endless nutritional benefits of breast milk one by one. Finally, Saradhasri of II M.Sc Biochemistry explained the immunological role of breast milk in children's health.

Awareness Programme on "Muscular Dystrophy: The Department of Biochemistry organised an awareness programme on "Muscular Dystrophy" on 10.02.2023 by Dr. Joel Selwyn M.D.

(General Medicine), Executive Member, Danny & Friends, Trichy. The Speaker's presentation mainly focused on types, causes, symptoms and treatment of Muscular dystrophy. He clearly explained that Muscular dystrophy is a spectrum of disease that causes progressive weakness and loss of muscle mass. He pontificated the signs and symptoms which typically appear in early childhood, might include frequent falls, trouble running and jumping, waddling gait and walking on the toes. He also elucidated that it can be diagnosed by Electromyography, elevated level of creatine phosphokinase enzyme and muscle biopsy. He clarified that this can be prevented by avoiding intimate relation marriage since it is mainly caused by mutations in genes.

Dr. V. Ravikumar, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Biochemistry, Bharathidasan University, Tiruchirappalli, delivered a talk on "Epigenetic Therapeutics in Cancer". He explained that the incidence of cancer is alarming in developed countries. He highlighted that epigenetic mechanisms are essential for the normal development and maintenance of tissue-specific gene expression patterns in mammals

One day Workshop on "Cytochemical Staining Techniques": The Department of Biochemistry organised a One-day workshop on "Cytochemical Staining Techniques" at PG instrumentation laboratory on 15.09.2022 by Dr. S.R. Senthil Kumar, Associate Professor, PG & Research Department of Botany, St. Joseph's College, Trichy. The Speaker's presentation mainly focused on localising the chemical components of the cell on thin histological sections by using several dyes. He clearly demonstrated the cytochemical techniques to identify diagnostically useful

substances in the cells, usually by the development of colour reactions. He pontificated the significance of different patterns in staining techniques to identify DNA, RNA, Polysaccharides and proteins in plant tissues. He also elucidated the precept of Toluidine blue O method, Methyl Green-Pyronin reaction and Coomassie Brillant Blue R method.

"Exposition of Vermicomposting"-28.11.2022: The Department of Biochemistry and Microbiology, Conducted a Workshop on "Exposition of Vermicomposting" by Dr.R. Senthil Kumar, Proprietor, Sri Amman BioCare & SAB Research Academy, Thanjavur on 28.11. 2022. The Speaker's presentation mainly focused on the qualities of a good Entrepreneur. He clearly demonstrated the significance of Vermicomposting and Vermiwash which is rich in humus and low production cost. He pontificated the different methods of producing Bio fertilizer.
