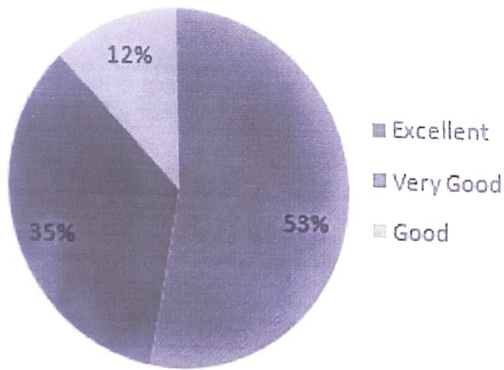

## FEEDBACK OF PARTICIPANTS ATTENDING THE TRAINING PROGRAMME

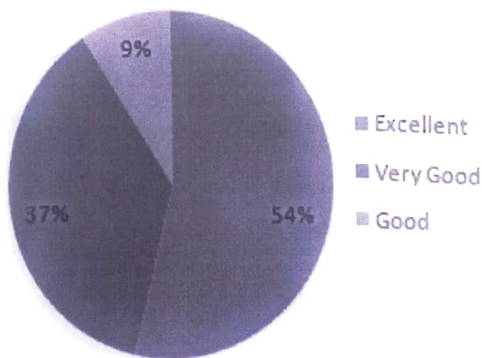

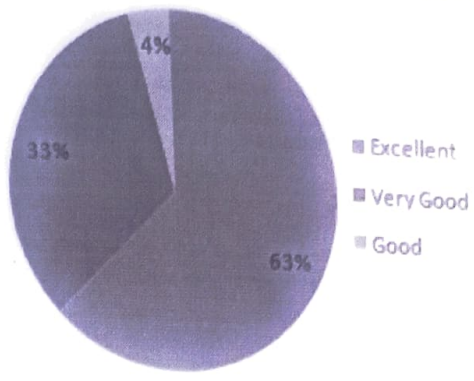
### Content of the Programme



**Ratings of the programme session:** The Participants were asked to provide the ratings of Programme session. 63% of participants mentioned excellent and 33% of participants

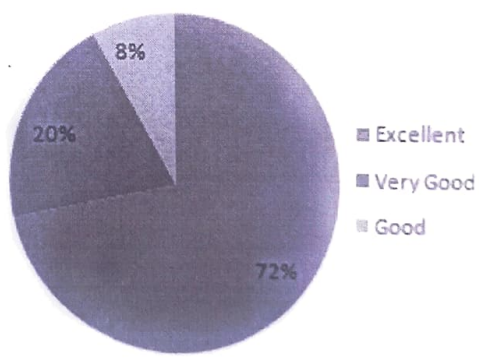
mentioned very good and 4% of participants mentioned good. This shows the good rating of the programme.
